2014/15

- A 'watershed' year for MW as the project moves from vision to reality..!!
- Since 2006: technical feasibility; RBWM policy support; WFD & planning consent; Stage 1 funding; tendering & now start of implementation
- RBWM partnership is key to delivery, for policy support & access to funding
- Area Action Plan underway alongside waterway, helping fund the project

2014/15 (cont.)

- Temporary dam Feb 2015
- Excavation & piling started Aug 2015
- Environment is being respected, improvement opportunities sought
- Community engagement a priority
- MW-managed Maintenance Plan backed by RBWM funding commitment
- MW strategy beyond Stage 1 developing
- Rotary planning additional support



Technical Progress

- Phase 1 (the 'Ring') consented Dec 2012
- Build stages agreed with RBWM & EA; timing to flex with funding availability
- Dan Evans joined MW as Special Adviser on ecological issues
- Ground water & flow monitoring MW own flow meter (Louis Baylis grant)
- Channel clearances continue for flow; reed spraying trials underway

- York Stream tree clearance completed
 2014, combined with Staff'n Way
- Greenford appointed Dec 2014 Stage 1
- Temporary dam installed Feb 2015
- Fish rescue as dam was closed
- Archaeological watching brief
- Channel works now underway
